Share Shed Receives Major Funding Boost

The **Share Shed**, the world's first mobile **Library of Things**, has received **£252,316** from the **National Lottery Community Fund**, expanding its reach across South Devon, including Buckfastleigh, over the next four years.

Led by the Network of Wellbeing, the project "Happier People and Stronger Communities through Share and Repair in South Devon" will help more residents borrow useful items, learn practical skills, and connect through community action.

With over **350 items** available, the Share Shed lets people borrow everything from **gardening tools and power drills to sewing machines and camping gear**, reducing waste and saving money.

The new funding will:

- Offer free memberships to low-income households
- Host more community events, Repair Cafés, and workshops
- Reduce carbon emissions by promoting borrowing over buying
- Support volunteers and partnerships with local groups
- Introduce smart lockers for out-of-hours borrowing
